Extension of Stay-at Home Order and Emergency Orders

The Government of Ontario has extended the provincial declaration of emergency and the Stayat-Home order (O.Reg 265/21) for an additional two weeks. The Stay-at-Home order is in place until May 5, 2021. In addition, effective Monday, April 19, the government is limiting the capacity of weddings, funerals, and religious services to 10 people indoors or outdoors. Additional measures being implemented are available in the news-release.

Emergency <u>orders currently in force</u> under the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act* have been extended until May 5. Orders currently in force under the *Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020*, with the exception of <u>O.Reg. 241/20</u> (Special Rules Re Temporary Pandemic Pay), have been extended until May 20, 2021.

Local Case of the Brazilian Variant

On April 16, Dr. Nicola Mercer, Medical Officer of Health and CEO of Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph Public Health released a letter to the community regarding the first local case of the Brazilian Variant. The full statement is available on our website.

Announcements and Changes to Services

- On April 19, <u>Dr. David Williams</u>, <u>Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health</u>, issued a statement regarding expanding COVID-19 vaccination eligibility <u>at pharmacies</u> and primary care settings to individuals aged 40 and over.
- On April 18, the Prime Minister, Justin Trudeau announced that the federal government is working to provide additional, emergency support to fight the COVID-19 outbreak in Ontario.
- On April 16, the <u>Government of Canada</u> announced that Ontario is receiving \$46 million to expand its efforts on virtual health care.
- On April 15, the <u>Government of Ontario</u> announced new red tape and burden reduction measures intended to minimize existing barriers on businesses and support a long-term recovery plan.
- On April 14, the <u>Government of Canada</u> announced the establishment of a Critical Drug Reserve, an additional safety net of key drugs used in the treatment of COVID-19 symptoms.
