Staying Up to Date with COVID-19 Vaccines

Protection after a primary COVID-19 vaccine series decreases over time, especially against the Omicron variant of concern. We recommend staying up to date with your COVID-19 vaccines. ("Up to date" means a person has received all recommended COVID-19 vaccine doses, including any booster dose(s) when eligible.) See <u>this chart</u> and the <u>Ministry of Health's Staying</u> <u>Up to Date with COVID-19 Vaccines: Recommended Doses</u> guidance for more information.

You can <u>use this online tool to calculate days since you last dose</u> to determine if you meet the minimum interval.
