Reg. 82/20</u>) Please note that <u>Ontario Regulation 82/20</u> was amended on January 14, 2021 to include the additional measures announced by the <u>Government of Ontario</u>, as outlined in <u>Enhancing Public</u> <u>Health and Workplace Safety Measures in the Provincewide Shutdown</u>.

Extension of Provincial Emergency

On January 25, the <u>Government of Ontario</u> extended the declared provincial emergency for another 14 days. The declaration of emergency made under section 7.0.1 of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act (EMCPA), <u>originally declared on January 12, 2021</u>, will now expire on February 9, 2021, unless extended further. All orders under the EMCPA, including O. Reg 11/21 (Stay-at-Home Order), O. Reg 8/21 (Enforcement of COVID-19 Measures) and O. Reg 13/21 (Residential Evictions) were also extended. Orders under the Reopening Ontario Act (ROA) continue to be in force.

Announcements and Changes to Services

- On January 26, the <u>Government of Ontario</u> announced it is providing \$5 million to support the province's Agricultural and Horticultural Societies impacted by the pandemic.
- On January 26, the <u>Government of Ontario</u> announced it is providing more than \$2.3 million to <u>McMaster University</u> and the <u>University of Toronto</u> through the Ontario Together Fund to carry out research, development and testing of the next generation of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- On January 25, the <u>Government of Ontario</u> announced it is accelerating the vaccination of residents in long-term care, high-risk retirement, and First Nations elder care homes by a new target date of February 5, 2021.



- On January 25, the <u>Government of Ontario</u> announced it is expanding eligibility for the targeted emergency child care program to additional workers who are performing critical roles in their communities.
- On January 22, the <u>Government of Canada</u> announced it is investing \$162.6 million in the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) over the next five years and \$40 million per year on an ongoing basis to maintain the integrity of Canada's food safety system, safeguard the food supply, and provide support to Canadian businesses in their export and import activities to overcome pandemic interruptions and global trade volatility.
- On January 22, the <u>Government of Canada</u> announced that it will deploy two federal Mobile Health Units (MHU) to Ontario, in response to a provincial request for assistance.
