Attitudes towards cannabis


70% agree
It would be easy to access cannabis in the next 24 hours




65% agree
Using cannabis is socially acceptable



77% agree
Using cannabis can be beneficial




23% agree

Cannabis knowledge


10% disagree
24% don't know
Using cannabis while pregnant can cause harm to the fetus/child




33% disagree
10% don't know
Using cannabis daily or almost daily can cause problems with memory, learning and decision-making



15% disagree
3% don't know
Using cannabis before driving increases your risk of a motor vehicle collision



47% disagree
5% don't know
Using cannabis may result in dependence or addiction




Non-medical cannabis usage

Of those who have used non-medical cannabis in the past year:

25% use cannabis daily



24% have driven a motor vehicle within two hours of using cannabis



Of those who have not used non-medical cannabis in the past year:

39% are moderately to very likely to try cannabis once legal.
