WDGPH will be distributing our first provincial allotment of Influenza vaccine the week of October 5, 2020. Public Health Unit's will be receiving a reduction in their allocation of IIV3-HD (High-Dose TIV). Approved pharmacies will have IIV3-HD available to administer to those 65+ years.

## Vaccine Viral Strain Components for the 2020-2021 Season

This year a cell/recombinant based vaccine has been added to the vaccine distribution.

**NOTE:** When available, IIV3-HD should be used for clients 65+ years, given the burden of influenza A (H3N2) disease and the evidence for better efficacy when compared with IIV3-SD in this age group. There is insufficient evidence to make comparative individual-level recommendations on the use of IIV4-SD over IIV3-HD, therefore if IIV3-HD is unavailable, immunization with IIV4-SD should be provided (NACI 2020-2021).

#### Available influenza vaccine distributed by the Ministry is:

- High-Dose Fluzone (IIV3-HD): 5 single dose prefilled syringes
- Flulaval-Tetra (IIV4-SD): Multi-dose vial (10 dose/vial)
- Fluzone Quadrivalent (IIV4-SD: Multi-dose vial (10 dose/vial) & 10 single dose prefilled syringes
- Flucelvax Quad (IIV4-SD: Multi-dose vial (10 dose/vial) & 10 single dose prefilled syringes
