

What to expect

After your vaccination

Common side effects:

- Swelling, tenderness or redness where the needle was given
- Minor muscle aches
- Mild fever
- Tiredness
- Headache

What to do:



- Put a clean, cold cloth over the sore area
- Continue to move your arm as much as possible
- Get a good night's sleep



When to seek immediate care:

See your doctor immediately or go to the nearest hospital emergency department if any of these symptoms develop:

- Swollen mouth, face or throat
- Hives, rash or itchy skin
- Difficulty breathing, wheezing or chest tightness
- Seizures or convulsions

Please inform your family doctor and Public Health if you have a reaction that may be related to a vaccine.
