

7 Substance-Related Poisonings in Guelph Today (February 8, 2024)

Substances circulating in the Guelph area may be stronger than usual, based on the following information:

- 7 substance-related poisonings in Guelph today (February 8, 2024).
- Evidence indicates involvement of fentanyl. Light green fentanyl has been identified, but it is likely that other colours/types may also pose similar risk.
- Please take care when using any unregulated drugs as supply may be stronger than usual.

Reduce your risk

- ✓ Carry naloxone
- ✓ Never use alone
- ✓ Start low and go slow (e.g., with any new purchase, start with 1/3 of a normal dose)
- ✓ Use the Consumption and Treatment Services Site (CTS) supervised by health professionals at Guelph's Community Health Centre
