

At Least 21 Drug Poisonings & One Fatality in the Past Week (August 29, 2025).



Stronger substances may be circulating in the Guelph region since August 21, contributing to a rise in poisonings.

- There have been at least 21 reported cases of substance-related poisonings and one fatality in the Guelph-Wellington area since August 21, 2025.
- Please exercise extreme caution when using unregulated drugs, as the current supply may be more potent and unpredictable than usual.



REDUCE YOUR RISK

While the Consumption and Treatment Service (CTS) at the Guelph Community Health Centre (GCHC) is now closed, strategies and supports are still available.



- Test your substances: Test strips are available from Sanguen, Wyndham House and WDG Public Health. A drug testing machine is also located at Guelph CHC at 176 Wyndham St. N.
- Carry naloxone: Naloxone is available and free at WDG Public Health, local pharmacies, the downtown library, and Guelph CHC.
- Avoid using substances alone: Call the National Overdose Response Services (NORS) at 1-888-688-NORS (6677) if you're by yourself.
- Start low, go slow: Use only a small amount of any new or unfamiliar substance.
- Share harm reduction information and resources.
- Connect to substance use and mental health supports.
