In the coming weeks, your office may receive a higher volume of calls for immunization records or to make an appointment for outstanding childhood vaccines.

The *Immunization of School Pupils Act* requires students to have up-to-date immunization records on file with Public Health to avoid being suspended from school.

- In November 2023, WDGPH sent Immunization Notices to *high school* students with incomplete records. Approx. 2,400 students remain at risk of suspension if these are not updated by February 14.
- This week, approx. 8,000 Immunization Notices were sent to parents/guardians of *elementary school* students with incomplete records. They have until **March 6** to update their records or face suspension.

# Administering Vaccines

The Immunization Notices sent to students (or their parents/guardians) specify which vaccine antigens they are considered overdue for. Please refer to <u>Ontario's Publicly Funded</u> <u>Immunization Schedule</u> for guidance about catch-up vaccinations.

Children who cannot be immunized for medical reasons need to have a Statement of Medical Exemption completed by their physician and submitted to Public Health. If parents are choosing not to immunize children for religious or conscientious reasons, there are other steps that they need to follow.
