- Order only for eligible patients;
 - Residing in long-term care homes or elder care lodges
 - Residents of all retirement homes (**NEW for 2024/2025**)
 - Patients in hospital receiving alternate level of care (ALC)
 - Patients receiving hemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis
 - Recipients of solid organ or hematopoietic stem cell transplants
 - Individuals experiencing homelessness
 - Individuals who identify as First Nations, Inuit or Métis
 - Pregnant individuals from 32 through 36 weeks gestational age
 - Infants born in 2024 prior to the RSV season
 - Infants born during the 2024/25 RSV season
 - Infants up to 24 months of age and are at high risk from RSV disease
