**Purpose:** To share information that will improve the COVaxON experience for WDG COVID-19 vaccine clinic staff and community partners.

## Important Updates and Information

---

### Dose 3 Eligibility Form – Pay Attention to the Version Date

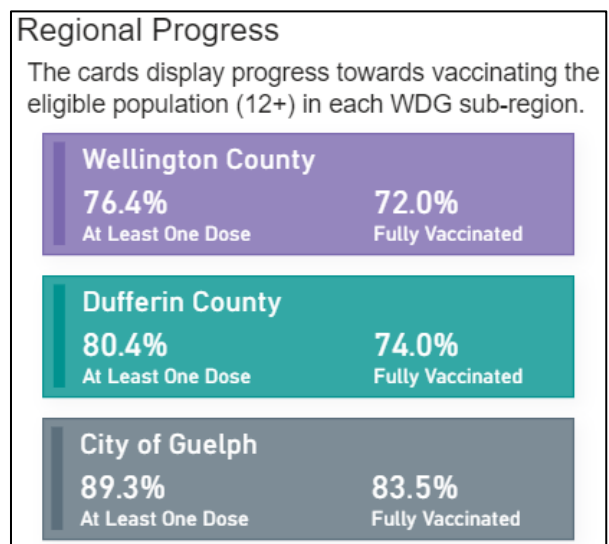
As per earlier communication, if a client arrives at a clinic for a third dose, they must either have the WDGPH Referral Form form or an alert on their COVax profile indicating that they are eligible to receive a third dose. The alerts will state either:

- **GRRCC** CONFIRMED ELIGIBILITY FOR THIRD DOSE, PT NOTIFIED ON \_\_(date)\_\_”
- **WDGPH** CONFIRMED ELIGIBILITY FOR THIRD DOSE, REFERRAL RECEIVED ON \_\_(date)\_\_”

If a client provides the WDGPH Referral Form, it is important that you are confirming that it is the correct form. The version date should indicate **August 18, 2021**. The form is attached to this e-mail for reference.

As we move forward in our efforts to vaccinate and protect our communities, it is important to note how far we have come. Please refer to the following graphics to see how our region is doing!

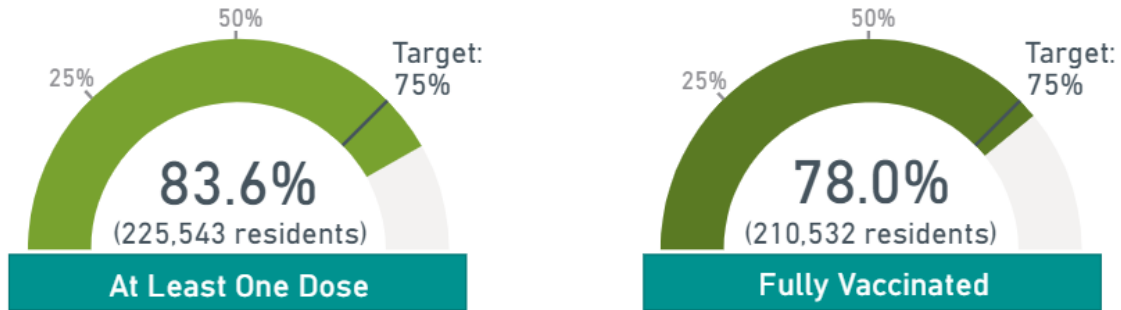


## Vaccination Progress

The gauges below display the vaccination progress for those with at least one dose of vaccine, and those who are fully vaccinated. Use the selector below to show percentages by different population groups.

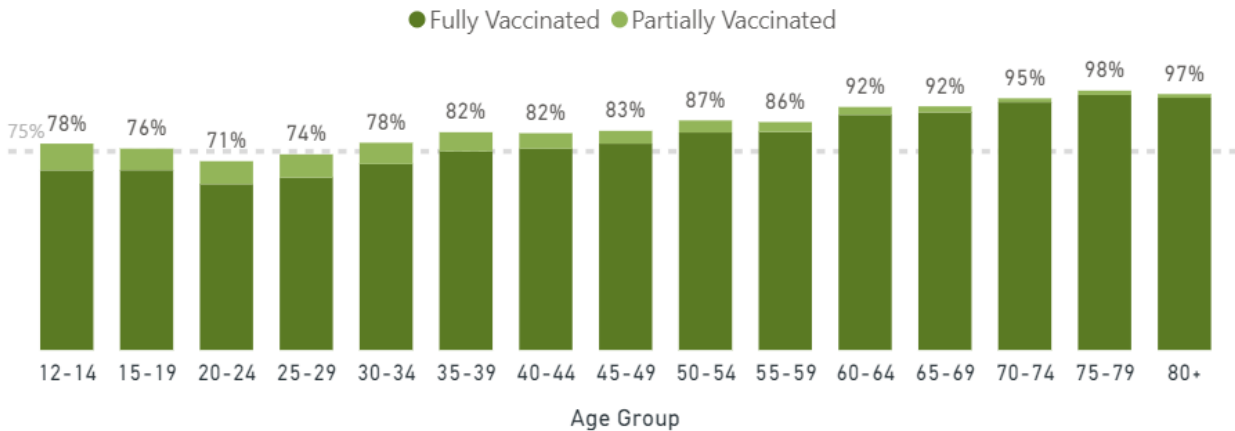
Eligible Population (Age 12+) ▾
